An organic energy-rich feed supplement for licking

For cattle, sheep, goats and fenced game

Composition:

Molasses*, monocalcium phosphate, sodium chloride, calcium carbonate, plant fatty acid (Palm*)

Benefits:

- Increases the activity and number of rumen microbes. This results in higher daily feed intake and higher forage digestion for a better performance and health
- Supplies animals <u>individually</u> with additional energy and minerals and vitamins.
- Contains no chemical hardeners or binders
- The principle of self-feeding, which saves work, expense and time.
- Weather resistant and therefore suitable for pasture feeding.
- Suitable for organic farming, certified by the EU-organic regulation Nr. 834/2007 and 889/2008

Feeding recommendation:

Feed to cattle, sheep and fenced game in the shed or on pasture to increase the forage intake. Ideally the 22.5 kg tubs should be used for a maximum of 10 cattle (20 sheep, goats, fenced game) and 25 cattle (50 sheep, goats, fenced game) for the 80 kg tubs. If possible always offer two tubs for every group to prevent hierarchical fights. In order to prevent the product softening do not place the tubs in direct sunlight during hot periods.

Daily consumption should be between 35 g - 75 g per sheep, goats or fenced game; for adult cattle between 150 g and 250 g. During initial feeding, the daily intake may increase to twice the normal amount. After 10 to 14 days the intake usually returns to normal. When this is not the case, nutrient or metabolic deficiencies must be considered.
